

Salt, Pepper, Spice Shakers and Toothpick Holder

Go green and be ecologically correct. Use a fallen tree or laminate scrap wood and turn on your lathe.



Oh, what a neat and easy project to make. Really, no plans are needed. Just cut off a limb from a fallen tree about 1-3/4" in diameter and cut to your choice of length.

Drill the hole thru it and recess for the rubber plug. Cut recess for the disk on top.

Sand the 3/4" hole and seal with a non toxic finish. It is best to pick wood that is dried out.

To mount the gold labels, clear off the bark from the bottom up so that you have a smooth area to stick the label on, cut label to size. No wood lathe needed but of course you can design your own and turn on the lathe or shape with hand tools. Or make your own design from glued up scrap wood and finish on the lathe.



Drill holes in the plastic colored 1-1/4" discs, white for salt, black for pepper and maroon for spices. Glue the disc on the top of the barrel to match the hole. Or drill a recess so the disc is flush. Clean off the bark of the limb at the bottom wide enough to attach the included labels or strip off the bark on the whole barrel, your choice.

The label was designed so you can cut it smaller if you need to. The tooth pick holder needs only a hole about 1-3/4" deep from the top.

Here is what you get in your kit:

3 - 1 1/4" plastic discs in 3 different colors.

1 each of the following attachable labels: salt, pepper, spice, toothpick. "Handcrafted by"

3 - 3/4" rubber pugs for the bottom of the shakers

1 plan

No other materials included. Caution: be sure to clamp down the disk when you are drilling the holes and use eye and hand protection. Observe all safety rules.
